(Discipleship and Reward)





THE CHRISTIAN LIFE SEEN AS A RACE

The Christian life begins with the new birth. At that point we are fully justified before God (Rom. 4:1-5; 5:1). After that, we start to live the Christian life, which is sometimes pictured as a race which we run. This race, our daily living, is where discipleship happens. Discipleship involves the process of life-long sanctification. Being a disciple means being a learner, a follower, of Jesus.

- Run the race set before us. Heb. 12:1-2
- Run in a way that you may win an incorruptible crown. 1 Cor. 9:24-27
- Press on towards the goal for the prize. Phil. 3:13-14
- Finish the race course well and gain the crown of righteousness. 2 Tim. 4:7-8

THE PRIZE

The prize is reward, not eternal salvation. Eternal salvation is a free gift, apart from works, whereas reward (recompense) is "according to works" (Matt. 16:27; Rev. 22:12). Rewards for the believer are decided at the Judgment Seat of Christ and the recompense can be positive or negative (2 Cor. 5:10; Eph. 6:5-8; Col. 3:23-25). The great positive reward (the prize) is ruling with Christ in His 1,000 year reign, and enjoying a special portion of eternal life in that age.

- Ruling with Christ in His future reign is dependent upon our endurance in following Christ in this life – Rom. 8:17; 2 Tim. 2:12
- Crowns, signifying rulership with Christ, are available for the faithful believer. 1 Cor. 9:24-27; 1 Thess. 2:19; 2 Tim. 4:8; Jas. 1:12; 1 Pet. 5:2-4
- •"Eternal life" in the age to come is a magnified enjoyment of fellowship with Christ in the 1.000 year kingdom, and is awarded for following Christ Mk. 10:28-30
